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Portfolio

- Each student will sign out for a portfolio
- The portfolios will be recycled do not write or tag on them.
- Each student is to keep supplies drawing and sketches in the portfolio
- Each students is to keep their portfolio clean and neat.
- Each student is responsible for the organizing the portfolio and for the items they are assigned and keep in the portfolio
- Portfolios will be returned at the end of the semester.

Paint Pots

- Each students will sign out 2 paint pots
- The paint pots are for keeping paint that the student is using for a project.
- These pots are to help save and not waste paint
- Paint will be supplied in the pots and not on palettes or on plates so as to save paint.
- Students will responsible for not wasting large amounts of paint.
- The pots must be returned at the end of the term.

Canvas and Other Surfaces

- No student will be allowed to take home blank canvas.
- School canvas are for school projects ONLY.
- Paintings on canvas must be begun at school and must be used for assigned projects.
- For the purposes of this course we will be investigating painting on other surfaces besides canvas (buckets, pieces of wood, fabric, etc;)
- Please bring any ideas for unique surfaces to paint on to Vikkie or Erik's attention.

Collage Items (?)

- One of the units will focus on collage and found object painting.
- Students are asked to begin saving items for this unit.
- Such items should be: wood, plastic, metal, paper, glass, pencils, bottle caps, keys, etc.
- The items saved should be small and should be things that can be attached to other surfaces and painted on.
- This is a tentative project which will depend on being able to gather items for it and time towards the end of the semester.

Personal Art Supplies

- Students may bring in their own art supplies for projects.
- Personal supplies are the responsibility of the student but may be kept in their assigned portfolio

Paint

- Each student is responsible for using paint efficiently.
- Any student that wastes paint will be asked to bring in their own paint for projects.
- Students will adhere to the instructions on how to use paint and the amount to be mixed and used at any one time.
- Students are to clean up all traces of paint from their area before they can leave for the day

Brushes

- Students are welcome to bring in and use their own brushes.
- Each student is responsible for washing the brushes they use.
- Brushes are to be COMPLETELY washed with warm water and soap.
- Brushes are to be replaced in their proper containers.
- Do NOT mix the brushes for different paints.
- (watercolor brushes, body paint brushes, acrylic paint brushes are to be kept separate)

School Supplies

- Supplies are kept in room 101 and the art room
- Students must sign out supplies
- The supplies in room 101 are kept in labeled draws and must be returned to their proper places at the end of the day.
- Students are responsible for keeping all areas clean and organized.
- All care is to be taken to protect tables and the carpeting in all areas

Responsibility

- Each student is expected to clean up the supplies they use and to take care of the art equipment they use.
- If you feel you cannot do this you are welcome to bring and use your own supplies.
- Be aware that the supplies you use should not be wasted. We offer you quality supplies and equipment so that you may learn and create the best possible pieces you are able to. Be respectful and mindful of this.
